To make collection of your child easier at the end of the day, we ask you to nominate a maximum of five people who can collect your child, should you be unable to collect.

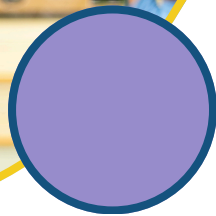
- They must be over the age of 18 years and do not necessarily have to be a family member.

About the School Day

- 8:00 am : Breakfast Club
- 8:25 am - 8:39 am : School Gates open, children go straight to class
- 8:40 am : School day begins
- 3:10 pm : School day ends

Breakfast Club

A breakfast club is available each morning from 8:00 am for year groups 3 to 6. Parents need to book in advance, by Friday the week before, and must drop their child(ren) in by 8:20 am at the Orchard Site. Cost of Breakfast Club payable via ParentPay is £2.50 per child.

School Dinners

Children can stay at school for dinner or they can bring a packed lunch. Meals are freshly prepared every day and there is a choice of menu including a vegetarian option and all meat served is halal. The kitchen also use Quorn mince (vegetarian option) in many of their dishes. The cost of a dinner is £2.70 per day which is bookable and payable via ParentPay.

School Uniform

We expect every child to wear our school uniform every day

Day to day uniform :

- Navy blue V-neck jumper or navy blue cardigan containing the Samuel Allsopp logo
- White school shirt - No polo shirts
- Grey tailored trousers or skirt
- Yellow and purple school tie – clip on
- Grey tights
- Optional - Purple gingham summer dress, for the Summer Term
- Sensible black shoes



PE Kit :

- Plain navy blue P.E. shorts/ Plain navy blue tracksuit bottoms OR leggings (not a combination of both)
- Sky blue P.E. top with the Samuel Allsopp logo
- Black P.E pumps for indoor use
- Trainers (to be kept in school) for outdoor use (NOT BLACK)
