We are pleased to let you know that swimming sessions have been arranged for Thursday afternoons starting **Thursday 12th September 2024**. Please be aware this is part of the national curriculum, not an optional activity.

Swimming sessions will be taking place at Meadowside Leisure Centre in Burton on Trent. School staff have visited Meadowside Leisure Centre and are reassured by the safety measures in place at the pool. Rest assured girls and boys will be changing in separate areas of the changing room.

Transport is provided, during which children **must** remain seated and seat belts worn at all times.

Please note, food should not be taken to swimming sessions. Deodorants, perfumes and sprays **are not** to be taken as they can affect other children.

Boys are asked to wear their swimming trunks to school on the day of swimming and bring underwear to change into after the lesson. Girls will be able to change before leaving school for the pool.

Please help us by sending your child with their swimming equipment every week; attached are guidelines of what equipment is needed for swimming.

Girls

- ✓ A tight fitting swimming costume.
- ✓ Swimming hat **must** be worn by any pupil with **long hair.**
- A towel
- ✓ Goggles (optional)

- × Deodorants, perfumes and sprays **ARE NOT** to be taken as they can affect other children.
- × NO food.

- ✓ Lycra Swimming trunks (note BAGGY SHORTS are **NOT** suitable).
- Swimming hat must be worn by any pupil with long hair

- ✓ Goggles (optional)
- × Jewellery should be left at home.
